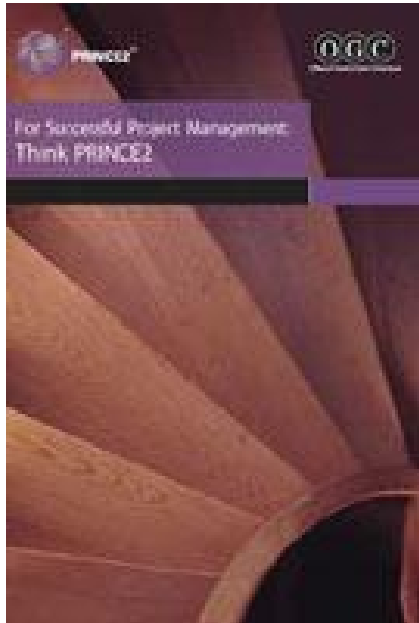




What is PRINCE2?



- Formerly known as PRINCE (and PROMPT before that!)
- Introduced because high profile project failures were too common
 - Launched in 1996
 - Currently in its 4th edition (2005)
 - Next version in development (2009)
- It is a **method** for managing projects



- **For Successful Project Management: Think PRINCE2**
 - An affordable introductory, practical guide to PRINCE2.
 - Official beginners guide written by practitioners provides a real view on PRINCE2, from a government organisation, private sector and not-for-profit global organisation perspective.



- **Agile Project Management: Running PRINCE2 Projects with DSDM Atern**
 - Based on PRINCE2 and DSDM, the two most established and internationally recognised project management approaches, this title explores the differences between the two approaches before showing where they overlap and how they can be integrated.

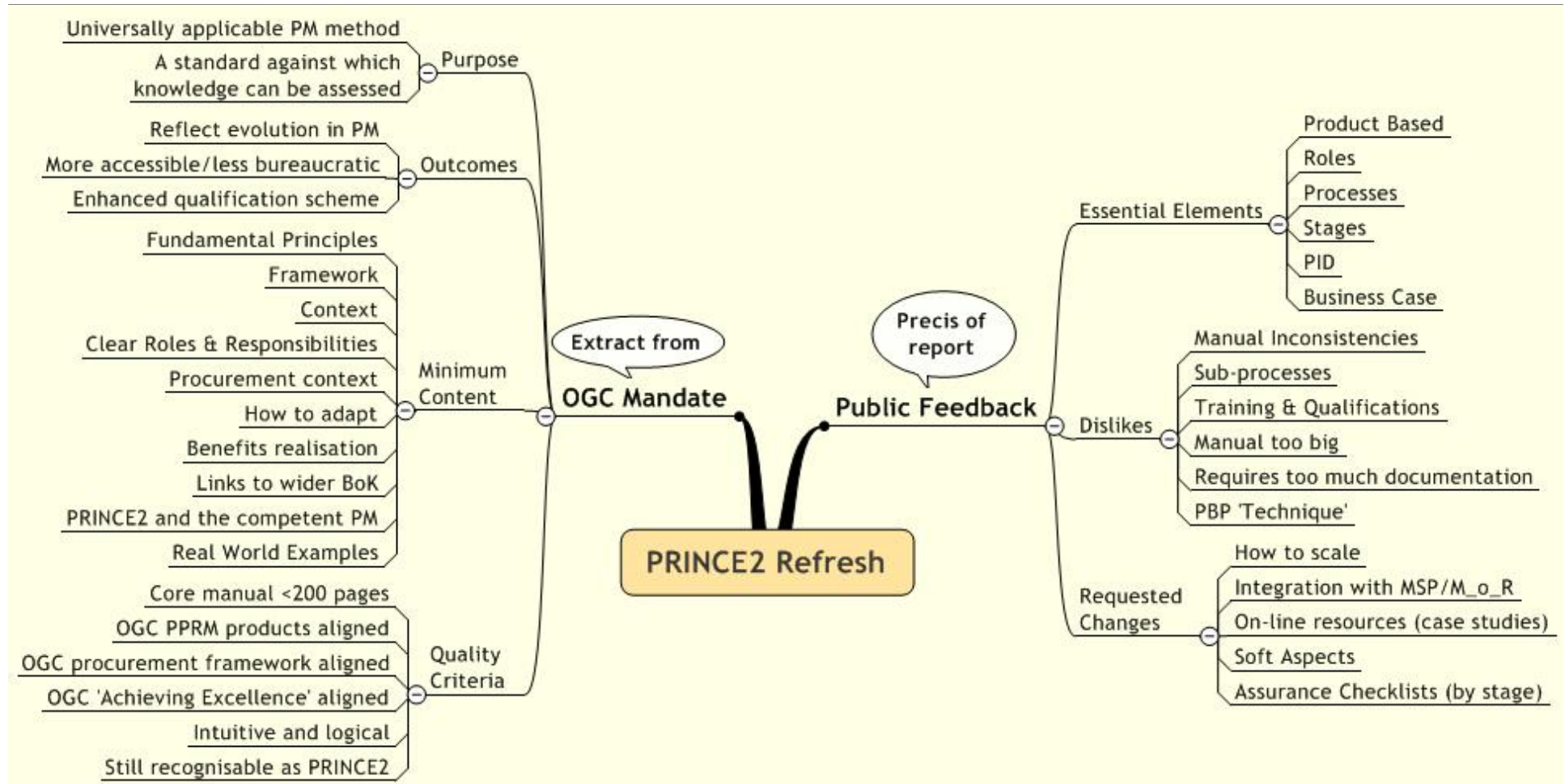


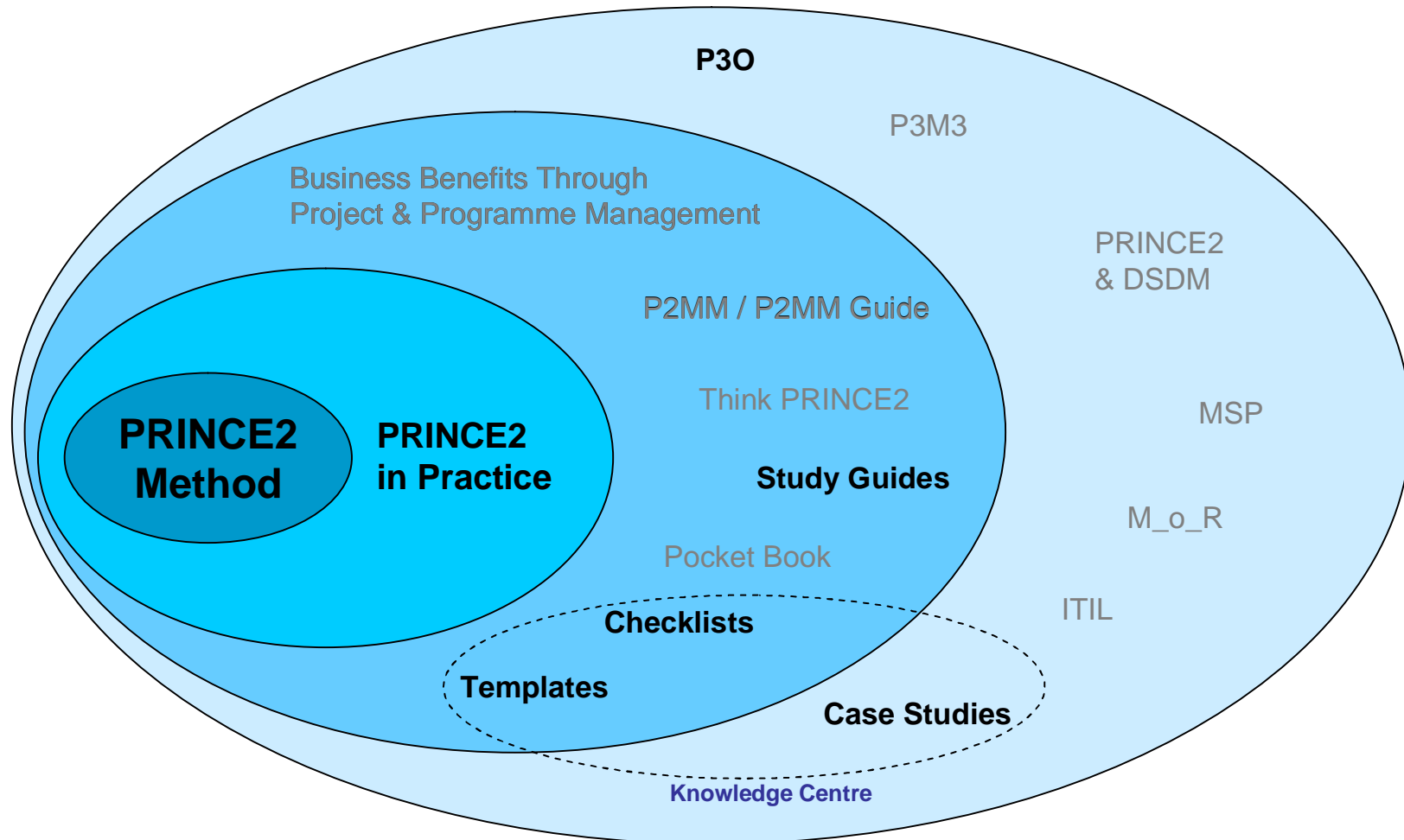
- **Improving Project Performance Using the PRINCE2™ Maturity Model**

Practical advice on how P2MM can be used:

- To help implement PRINCE2 (first time users)
- To re-invigorate/enhance existing PRINCE2 implementations
- To help organisations improve their project performance by going beyond training and templates (i.e. overcoming the issue of PRINCE in Name Only - PINO)
- As a benchmark to assess organisational capability, plan improvements and measure the improvements
- For organisational accreditation
